Quilt Fiesta 2018 KIDS ROW QUILT ENTRY FORM

Please complete all spaces on 2nd page of entry form. Use one form per entry, please

1. Kids must be 17 years old or younger to participate in Kids Row.
2. You must staple a 4" X 6" photograph of your quilt to this form (above right)
3. All entries must be available to hang for all 3 days of the **Quilt Fiesta**: Feb. 16, 17, 18, 2018
4. All work on the quilt must be done by the child. (Adults may help with the quilting and binding and provide assistance and guidance that is appropriate to the age of the child)
5. Quilts must have a 4" sleeve on the back for hanging purposes.
6. **Entry forms** are due by **November 8, 2017**. They may be turned in at either Guild General Meeting (Nov. 7th or 8th) or mailed, to Diane Bach, postmarked by the above date.
7. **Quilts must be turned in at either of the February 6th or 7th 2018 General Meetings or by February 9th, 2018 at a participating Quilt Shop. (The Quilt Basket, The Quilters Market)** They will be available for pick up at the same shop after February 21, 2018
8. Quilts will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Multiple entries may be accepted if space is available. Please number your **First Choice** with "**# 1**"

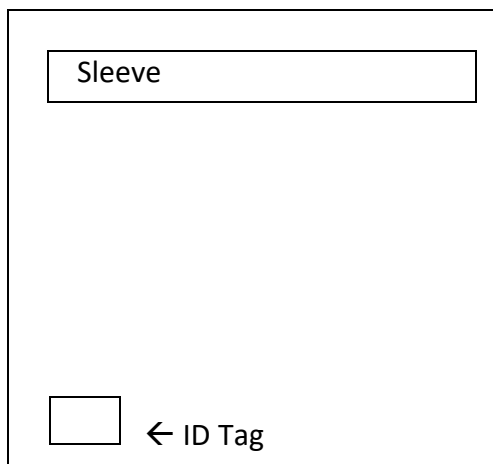

Instructions for making a 4" sleeve:

1. Cut or piece together a piece of muslin or other fabric that is 8 ½ inches in depth (wide) and as long as the width of the quilt for which the sleeve is intended.
2. Turn a one inch hem to the outside at each end and machine stitch. Fold the 8 ½ piece in half lengthwise with the end hems on the outside. Sew a ¼ inch seam along the raw edges. Do NOT TURN
3. Position the sleeve so that the raw edges of the seam are facing the back of the quilt. Pin the sleeve across the back below the binding. The sleeve should now measure 4 inches in depth. Whip stitch the sleeve to the back of the quilt, across the top and the bottom of the sleeve. Be careful that your stitches do not go through to the front of the quilt.
4. When your quilt is hung, the rod will go through the sleeve and not between the sleeve and the back. The rod will not catch, since the hems are facing to the outside and the seam is facing the back.
